## Rules

- I. This contest is open to students from 4th through 12th grades. Entries will be separated into Junior (4th-8th grades) and Senior (9th-12th grades) age divisions.
- II. The participant must be the primary creator of this dish and the dish must be MADE FROM SCRATCH. No pre-packaged mixes are allowed. Adult supervision is advised and assistance may be given if and when necessary, but let this be the student's project.
- III. Each student may enter in as many categories as he or she likes, but each entry must have its own entry form and each category may only be entered once.
- IV. Participants must provide a recipe card listing all ingredients, amounts and instructions.
- V. There is no charge for this event, however, an entry form is required for each entry.
- VI. Entries must be displayed on a disposable plate or tray. Dishes will not be returned.
- VII. All entry **forms** must be received by the **Habersham County Extension** Office by September 1st, 2011. You may mail them to **555 Monroe St., Box 13 Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523**. Or you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- VIII. All entries must be delivered to the Fairgrounds on Sunday, September 11, 2011 between 1:00 PM and 2:00 PM. Judging will begin at 2:30. Biscuits will be judged first in order to keep them as warm as possible. Public tasting will begin after the judges make their decisions.
- IX. The Fair Committee will not be responsible for lost or eaten entries.
- X. All entries must be labeled on the back of the recipe card with the participants name, school and grade. Entries labeled on the front or not at all will not be eligible for judging.
- XI. Dessert-type entries will be based on TASTE and not APPEARANCE. Biscuit entries will be judged on quality, taste and appearance. Tasting will be open to the public after entries are judged.
- XII. The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation.
- XIII. Biscuit contestants should bring at least 3 biscuits to be judged. More than 3 is fine, but less than 3 is not.
