Cattle Show Rules

All steers and heifers must be in place no later than 5 pm the day of show.

All steers and heifers must be born on or after September 1, 2010.

All animals must have an official health certificate.

Commercial heifer classes will be determined by weight. There will be no reweighs after heifer is checked in.

Steers classes will be determined by weight. There will be no reweighs after steer is checked in.

Prize money will be awarded based upon available funds.

The show committee reserves the right to change, combine or delete classes with insufficient entries.

The decisions made by the show committee regarding rules and regulations will be final.

Registered heifers must present registration certificate at the time heifers are checked in.

Exhibitor, parent, teacher or agent must sign entry form. The form will be returned if not signed.

All tack and trim chutes will be restricted to designated areas.

No nails or screws will be used in barn facility.

Exhibitor must show their own animal unless exhibitor has more than one animal in class. Exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship class.

All complaints must be filed with show committee on the day of show. Exhibitor must fill out complaint form explaining grievance.

Animals may be shown clean or full fit.

Neck ropes must be used for securing animals and will be provided by exhibitor.

All animals will be dehorned.

All animals must be of show quality.

All animals must be halter broken and shown at halter.

Exhibitor will be responsible for disposal of waste in their assigned area.

The show committee will provide bedding. Must tie in county groups.
