Market Goat Show Rules & Regulations

- All entry fees are due before August 26, 2022 cash, cashier's check and money orders will be accepted.
- Please have your pass and vehicle pass for admittance into the livestock gate.
- ***The livestock gate will be CLOSED at 5pm. If you are hauling tack, please make sure you arrive before 5pm. If you arrive after 5pm, please park in the parking lot and come in through the ticket booths.
- Exhibitor & parent must sign entry forms. Forms will be returned if it is not signed.
- Only 2 entries per exhibitor.
- *All does and weathers will be shown together by weight in the same show.*
- *Only bring goats that are entered in the show. Space is Limited.*
- Goats must arrive and be checked in between 2pm and 5pm the day of the show.
- Exhibitors must have official health papers to be eligible to show.
- The market Goat show is open to students in Habersham, White, Stephens, Towns, Banks, Hall, Rabun and Jackson Counties.
- All goats will be shown by weight.
- All goats must be owned by the exhibitor on or before August 1, 2022.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal in showmanship class and in weight class unless the exhibitor has more than one animal in the same class.
- Showmanship is open only to exhibitors with an animal entered into the show.
- The show committee reserves the right to change, combine, or delete classes with insufficient entries.
- There will be limited pen space available and is a first come first serve basis.
- All tack and trim tables will be restricted to designated areas. Clipping is allowed in the barn, but PLEASE clean the area when finished.
- The decisions made by the show committee regarding show rules and regulations will be final.
- All complaints must be filed with the show committee on the day of the show. Exhibitors must fill out a complaint form explaining grievance. These will be available at the show desk the day of the show.
