THE RULES

- The Fair Committee will provide each participant with a bar of soap, a plastic knife, toothpicks (for intricate carving), a paper plate, and paper towels.
- Each participant may only carve one bar of soap.
- Each participant must provide any additional decorations. These decorations may not pierce the soap but may be attached by other means.
- There is no charge for this event. However, an entry form is required for each participant.
- If any soap carving is deemed inappropriate by the fair committee or its representatives, it will be removed from the judging and display area.
- The Habersham County Extension Office must receive all entry forms by September 1, 2023. Documents may be emailed to uge1137@uga.edu. You may mail them to 555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 25, 2023. Or, you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- The Fair Committee will not be responsible for lost or stolen entries, decorations, or other materials.
- The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation.
- Walk-up participants will be allowed if enough materials are available. Walk-up participants will not be reimbursed for entry fees.
- Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair. Multiple entries do not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge.
- Entries may be picked up at the fairgrounds on Sept. 17 between 12-2 pm or at the 4-H office on Sept. 18-20. Any items left after Sept 25 will be discarded or donated. Entries must remain on display until September 16, 2023. Entries may be picked up at the fairgrounds or the Extension office after the fair.
