



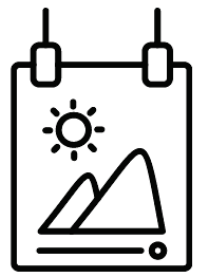

THE RULES

- **This year's theme is- "The fair is special because..... "**
- Each student may enter only one poster for judging.
- Entries must be no larger than half of one sheet of poster board (Maximum dimensions of 14" X 22").
- There is no charge for this event. However, an entry form is required for each entry.
- The Habersham County Extension Office must receive all entry forms by September 1, 2023. Documents may be emailed to uge1137@uga.edu. You may mail them to 555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 25, 2023. Or, you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- If any entry is deemed inappropriate by the fair committee or its representatives, it will be removed from the judging and display area.
- Students will receive free admission on Saturday, September 9, 2023. Names will be at the admission gate ONLY on the contest day.
- The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation
- Posters may be delivered to the fairgrounds between 4:00 and 6:30 PM on Thursday, September 7, 2023, or to the Habersham County Extension office before then.
- The Fair Committee will not be responsible for lost or stolen entries.
- All entries must be labeled on the back with the participant's first and last names, school, and grade. Entries marked on the front or not at all will not be eligible for judging.
- Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair. Multiple entries do not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge.
- Entries will be displayed until the end of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be picked up at the Habersham County Extension office the week after the fair closes.
- Entries may be picked up at the fairgrounds on Sept. 17 between 12-2 pm or at the 4-H office on Sept. 18-20. Any items left after Sept 25 will be discarded or donated. Entries must remain on display until September 16, 2023. Entries may be picked up at the fairgrounds or the Extension office after the fair.
